# MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 14, 2015 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KENSINGTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

# CALL TO ORDER:

President Nagel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and welcomed new Director Don Dommer. Nagel noted that all Board members were present as well as staff.

# APPROVAL OF CONSENT ITEMS:

President Nagel called for the approval of the consent calendar (items 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9), consisting of approval of the September 9, 2015 minutes, July incident activity report, August incident activity report, September incident activity report, approval of monthly transmittal #4, approval of the monthly August/September 2015 financial report and approval of policy handbook changes listed. Director Nagel removed items 4, 5 and 6 from the consent calendar at resident Rick Artis' request. Director Kosel moved the adoption of the consent calendar items 3, 7, 8 and 9 as submitted. Director deVille seconded the motion.

# **ORAL COMMUNICATIONS:**

Director Dommer stated he was glad to be back on the Board of Directors. He attended the CSDA annual conference in late September and suggested a Brown Act discussion for a future Board meeting. Dommer will provide the slides from the program he attended at the conference for the Board packet.

Manager Navellier reported that the District will be holding a second shredding event during 2015 on Saturday, November 7<sup>th</sup>. Also, a toy drive/pasta feed will take place at Station 65 on November 14<sup>th</sup>. Both dates will be in the Fire Plug which is due to be published any day. Director Kosel suggested obtaining the KIC sign board for both events.

President Nagel reported that a water main broke at Trinity Avenue. The fire department, police department and CERT team all responded. It was an excellent example of a cooperative effort.

Director Kosel said that she attended KFPD's CPR/First Aid training on October 10<sup>th</sup> and congratulated Chief Maples on the excellent job his staff, Captain Brian Cheshareck and Captain Tom McCullagh, did.

# ITEMS 3, 4 and 5 - INCIDENT ACTIVITY REPORTS:

Rick Artis pointed out data in the July report that does not match. He believes it is the product of an improper sort. He reviewed specific concerns which the Chief and the Board reviewed. Chief Maples will review with the Battalion Chief that compiles the information and bring all three reports back to the Board. Artis requested an agenda item for future discussion on response times by the Board. Maples said he is more than willing to have staff meet with Artis to review response time data. Artis said the recently published response times in the newspaper are El Cerrito times. Chief Maples said that they are combined El Cerrito and Kensington times. There are geographic differences in the districts. El Cerrito's response times are lower than Kensington's specifically. Chief Maples will bring back all three incident activity reports to the December meeting and give a presentation on response times. Artis pointed out that the raw data that staff gave him does not match the submitted reports for August and September. Further discussion followed on data specifics.

# FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Maples reported again that it has been a very busy fire season. The department responded to 10 different out-of-area fires. All resources are in District at this time. The cost for these responses are fully reimbursable by the State. The community of Kensington has been redesignated a Heart Safe Community by County Health Services largely due to the CPR classes that Captain Tom McCullagh teaches and the public AEDs throughout the community. Engineer/Paramedic David Hood will be taking over this program from McCullagh who is retiring. The Columbia water system improvements are almost complete and should be done by November 1<sup>st</sup> aside from paving. The apparatus room construction is on track to be complete before the end of the month. The

contractor is working on punch list items and clean up. The delivery of Engine 65 is being pushed back to December. With all of the fire activity in the state, the vendor has been busy working on broken rigs instead of production. The drug drop-off in partnership with KPPCSD was a huge success. Over 100 lbs. of drugs was collected. The department received an email thank you from a former resident that had attended a defensible space talk that B/C Bond gave. Those residents later moved to an area affected by the Valley Fire but their home was spared because they had completed vegetation management all around their property. The pasta feed/toy drive will take place on November 14<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m.

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

President Nagel reported that the second Wednesday in November falls on Veteran's Day, a federal holiday. The Board has moved their monthly meeting to Wednesday, November 18<sup>th</sup>. The Board will meet at the fire station due to scheduling conflicts at the community center.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

El Cerrito-Kensington Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) presentation by Cheryl Miller of Diablo Fire Safe Council: Cheryl Miller explained that CWPP are authorized and defined in the Healthy Forest Restoration Act passed in 2003. In 2009 the first Contra Costa County CWPP provided a county-wide overview of hazards and strategies to reduce risk. Since 2009, DFSC and partners in Contra Costa and Alameda Counties have been awarded over \$950,000 of grant funds for activities identified in the CWPPs. Now, DFSC, in partnership with Kensington Fire Protection District and El Cerrito Fire Department, has received a \$3,900 grant to work with the two communities. During FY15-16, residents will have the opportunity to help prioritize outreach and education, training and specific fuel reduction projects. Miller reviewed the four-step process of the action plan - planning preparation, review of the existing CWPP and brainstorming, develop an action plan, and then adopt the action plan. Miller then reviewed the different grant funding that is available for this project. She reviewed outreach planning, educational training, and specific planning projects for the District. DFSC currently has a \$5,000 vegetation management cost sharing program that residents in a group of five can apply for. Part of the review of the grant process is that projects must comply with the District's vegetation management standards. The cost sharing dollars could be used for juniper removal but cannot be used for replanting. However, the cost of replanting could be considered the cost sharing match. Navellier will add a paragraph in The Fire Plug about the funding available to residents. Kosel said KFPD is working with KPPCSD on a community, drought resistant garden. KFPD has also budgeted matching donations to DFSC based on what is donated by the community. The cost sharing program can also be used by neighbors to help clean up properties that don't comply with the vegetation standards. There is a process involved with working with EBRPD on their land. DFSC would very much welcome another Kensington group to work with in the area. Kosel offered the District website for the CWPP plan and the cost sharing grants. Director Kosel made a motion to endorse KFPD's participation in the CWPP action plan as embodied in the Board packet hand out and presentation. Director deVille seconded the motion.

Community Emergency Shed Partnership with KPPCSD: Chief Maples said that Chief Hart of KPPCSD learned about the KFPD's community CERT Shed program that is being developed. Hart approached KFPD offering a place in the park to locate a community shed with emergency supplies that KFPD would provide. Hart has taken the item to his Board and they have authorized him to work with KFPD to place a shed on the park property at KFPD's cost for the purpose of emergency supplies not to exceed 25 feet. The CERT sheds were originally designed to hold tools for those that have been through the CERT program. Hart discussed food, water, and blankets at his Board meeting. That is not the list of items that Navellier provided him with. Food and water have expiration dates and residents are encouraged to have their own caches of those supplies. President Nagel suggested we need to have a plan for residents that don't have one. Possibly the District could apply for a FEMA grant. Kosel said Chief Maples and staff should select the contents as the experts and since the District would be financing the project. Her hope is that this community shed will inspire the different CERT areas to place a shed in their area and there will be six sheds in place by the end of the fiscal year. KPSC may be able to help identify sites. Cambridge Avenue has had a robust earthquake group for 25 or 30 years now. They have a shed for their neighborhood. Kosel suggested buying a regular sized shed to place next to the larger one to be placed in the park so that people could actually see how big the CERT shed will be. Maples suggested supporting the neighborhoods that already have sheds by boosting their inventory, etc. Director Dommer said the community center needs to be an

essential services building and shelter. In that case, the shed should have more of the perishable items. Maples said that is an option but the Board needs to realize that would be an on-going cost. Maples said the Red Cross will also show up with food and blankets, etc. KPPCSD has selected the site already. KFPD is considering some type of modular building, not a container. Ciara Wood said folks on Purdue are considering a tool-lending shed so more neighbors can work on fuel reduction. Rick Artis asked about a generator in the sheds. Maples said they have not decided yet on propane or gas and fuel would have to be rotated. The Board agreed by consensus to move forward with a shed program on KPPCSD park property not to exceed \$15,000. The shed would not have power or water. Board member Dommer will work with staff to develop the park property shed.

KFPD Policy, Employee and Operations Handbook - Proposed Amendment to Policy 1080 - Board Meeting Conduct: Director Kosel said the addition to the Policy was triggered by her and Director Dommer's attendance at the CSDA conference in September. The proposed addition limits each speaker to no more than five minutes and a maximum of 20 minutes to each subject matter. The policy could always be waived if necessary. The proposed limits are from the CSDA sample policy manual. Rick Artis said the Board needs to decide how they are going to enforce the limit; it cannot be enforced whimsically. Kosel said this is a perfect time to adopt this policy since it is not directed at any particular issue or person but a result of the CSDA conference. Director Kosel made a motion to revise Policy 1080 as reflected in the Board packet. Director Dommer seconded the motion.

## **BOARD REPORTS:**

Finance: Director Kosel met with Wells Fargo Advisors at the CSDA conference. Wells Fargo will attend the District's Board meeting in November to discuss laddering investments with Wells Fargo instead of investing in LAIF. Wells Fargo advisors believe they could generate about 1.7% interest for the District as opposed to the .20% that LAIF is paying at virtually no increased risk. Navellier and Russell will review the financials to check the amount of how much can be invested at Wells Fargo. This would also require a change in our investment policy. One fifth of the District's investments would mature a year. Wells Fargo will provide a power point next month. The Committee should get a draft audit around the end of the year or January. Kosel reviewed that the investments are money that the District sets aside for purchasing replacement engines, the building and the contract fee.

Public Safety Building: Director Harmon said she received a tour and everyone will get to see the apparatus room remodel at the pasta feed.

Education: The Fire Plug is at the press and will be mailed to every household in Kensington. The next

shredding event will take place on November 7th.

CSDA: Director Nagel attended the last CSDA Chapter meeting which was in July. He gave an overview of that meeting where there was a special LAFCO meeting to vote for an alternate to replace the late George Schmidt. Stanley Caldwell was elected. Drought create a major problem with mosquitos and West Nile virus. All dead birds need to be reported. There was a presentation by San Ramon Valley FPD on hands-on CPR with and without an AED. The scholarship committee gave \$1,000 to the teacher of the year program. LAFCO held an open space workshop with 70 attendees and is working on the second round of the fire service MSRs. The next meeting will be held on October 19th.

Correspondence: An email was received from Ciara Wood celebrating a neighbor's removal of junipers.

Director Dommer announced that he will be having a medical procedure and may not make it to the November meeting. President Nagel reminded everyone that next meeting will be on the 18th at the Fire Station.

Attached are the Incident Activity Reports for the months of July through November that cover all incidents within the Kensington community and total incidents that Engine 65 responded to in that same time frame. During these 5 months there were a total of 166 calls in Kensington and during the same time, Engine 65 responded to a total of 299 calls.

There is a summary page that provides the response details for each month as well as the total calls for Kensington and Engine 65. The auto-aid agreement with Berkeley is in place and Engine 65 has responded to two structure fires in Berkeley, both fortunately were extinguished upon arrival. Engine 65 also responded to a vegetation fire in the Tilden Park area in August and was the first engine to initiate a hose lay on one side and was instrumental in containing the fire to a small area in the drought stricken area.

At the Boards request, in addition to these monthly activity reports, I have reviewed the response times for both El Cerrito and Kensington for the calendar year 2014. The follow are the median and 90% response times for all priority calls in Kensington, El Cerrito and combined.

Kensington: Median Response Time – 4:59 90% Response Time – 7:36

El Cerrito: Median Response Time – 4:24 90% Response Time – 6:50

Combined: Median Response Time – 4:27 90% Response Time – 6:52




There were 38 incidents that occurred during the month of August in the community of Kensington. Please see the attached "Incident Log" for the dates and times locations and incident type for these calls that the Fire Department responded to this past month. Kensington calls are shown in the charts at the bottom of this page. During this month E65 responded to a total of 65 calls in all districts.

On August 16, 2015, Engine 365 responded mutual aid to a vegetation fire in the Tilden Park/Berkeley Hills area along with units from Oakland, Berkeley, East Bay Parks, Moraga – Orinda and Call Fire. Engine 365 initiated fire attack on one side of the fire and was committed for a few hours with overhaul.

On August 27, 2015, Engine 65 responded to a possible structure fire on Highland Blvd. The home owner has left a gas barbeque that was built into a stucco structure on all night and awoke to find it on and smoke coming from around the structure. Upon further investigation, Engine 65 found that the heat from the appliance that charred the wood framing behind the stucco and they were smoldering. Engines 65 removed the barbeque and overhauled the wall removing a lot of the stucco to access and extinguish the fire. Damage was estimated at \$5,000.00


